Language proficiency and the right to education in the age of AI

The webinar will be led by Pablo Meix Cereceda, Associate Professor of Administrative law, who teaches Administrative Law at the University of Castilla-La Mancha (Spain) and is currently visiting the University of Macau, where he is researching (and teaching) ‘law, language and logic’. He has devoted most of his publications to education law, but he has recently published a book on ‘Language, Power, and Law in the Information Age’ (in Spanish).

Audiovisual technologies have become central to modern societies and to the lives of many young people and children. For several decades, social networks and other platforms have sought to increase screen time as a leisure activity, with considerable success. Furthermore, especially since the Covid-19 pandemic, much of education has also turned digital, even in the classroom. But we also know that language is important for intellectual development. This raises the question: are audiovisual technologies affecting the linguistic skills of the digital native generation? If so, would this be reflected in educational success? Can the law prevent intellectual impoverishment? What role does education have to play? In an age of generative AI, how relevant is it to write properly? Could educational AI tools such as ChatGPT’s ‘Study Mode’ help? These and other related questions will be the focus of the discussion.
