
When do we use the present simple & continuous?

Routines, habits, permanent situations

Present simple or continuous?

Temporary situations, at the moment.

Present simple or continuous?



Examples

I play tennis

- On Mondays
- Every day / week / month / year
- Frequency adverbs: always, often, frequently, sometimes, seldom, occasionally, rarely, hardly ever, never
- Facts

d am playing tennis

Now, right now, at the moment, these days, nowadays

FUTURE FORMS

When do we use will and be going to?

Future plans, intentions, predictions BASED ON EVIDENCE.

Will or going to?

Promises, offers, spontaneous or instant decisions, predictions NOT BASED ON EVIDENCE, suggestions, future facts

Will or going to?

PRESENT CONTINUOUS FOR TALKING ABOUT THE FUTURE

We use it for future arrangements, like a wedding, travel arrangements, a meeting, etc.


You can use either "going to" or the present continuous, since they essentially mean the same.

My flight is taking off at 11:00 am

They are getting married in August.


